SYSTEM OF DAFFODIL CLASSIFICATION

DIVISION 1 – TRUMPETS: the trumpet (corona) is as long or longer than the perianth segments.

DIVISION 2 – LARGE CUP: the cup (corona) is less than the length of the petals (perianth) but more than a $\frac{1}{3}$.

DIVISION 3 – SMALL CUP: the cup (corona) is less than $\frac{1}{3}$ of the length of petals (perianth).

DIVISION 4 – DOUBLES: one or more flowers to the stem, with doubling of the perianth segments or the corona or both.

RULES

1. All entry forms from intending exhibitors must be returned to the Show Secretary, Mr. Charles Mobsby, 17 Padnell Road, Cowplain PO8 8DZ, before 6pm on the Friday evening prior to the Show.
2. Each exhibitor is limited to only **ONE** exhibit in any one Class. Staging of the exhibits may be carried out from **9am - 11am** on the day of the Show.
3. The decision of the judges, in respect of the relative merits of exhibits, is final and the judges have the right and the power to withhold any prize where the exhibits are considered unworthy.
4. The judging will be in accordance with the Rules and Standards of the Royal Horticultural Society and the National Association of Floral Arrangement Societies.
5. No exhibits are to be removed until after the prize giving at approximately 4pm.
6. Vases will be available at the Show and these are to be emptied by the exhibitor and returned at the end of the Show.

OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

Open 1. 3 Vases each containing 3 stems of one cultivar. Three out of the four Divisions 1-4 to be represented,

Open 2. Vase of 6 blooms from not less than two Divisions.

CLOSED CLASSES (MEMBERS ONLY)

1. 1 VASE – TRUMPET DAFFODILS: Yellow, 1 variety (Daffodil Division 1) 3 blooms
2. 1 VASE – TRUMPET DAFFODILS: Any colour combination, other than as Class 1, 1 variety (Daffodil Division 1) 3 blooms
3. 1 VASE – LARGE CUPPED NARCISI 1 variety (Daffodil Division 2) 3 blooms
4. 1 VASE – SMALL CUPPED NARCISSI 1 variety (Daffodil Division 3) 3 blooms
5. 1 VASE – DOUBLE DAFFODILS: 1 variety (Daffodil Division 4) 3 stems
6. 1 VASE – ANY OTHER CLASSIFICATION OF DAFFODIL/NARCISSI: Not included in the above divisions. 1 variety 3 stems
7. 1 VASE – TRUMPET DAFFODIL: Yellow (Daffodil Division 1) 1 bloom
8. 1 VASE – TRUMPET DAFFODIL: Any colour combination, other than as Class 1 (Daffodil Division 1) 1 bloom
9. 1 VASE – LARGE CUPPED NARCISSUS (Daffodil Division 2) 1 bloom
10. 1 VASE – SMALL CUPPED NARCISSUS (Daffodil Division 3) 1 bloom
11. 1 VASE – DOUBLE DAFFODIL (Daffodil Division 4) 1 stem
12. 1 VASE – ANY OTHER CLASSIFICATION OF DAFFODIL/NARCISSI: Not included in the above divisions 1 stem
13. 1 POT OF DAFFODILS: Cultivar: 'Binkie' Pot not to exceed 228mm 6 bulbs
14. NARCISSI IN PEBBLES AND WATER: Cultivar: 'Sir Winston Churchill' 12 bulbs max
15. 1 POT OF DAFFODILS: 1 Cultivar: (excluding varieties in Classes 13 and 14) Pot not to exceed 228mm. Please name cultivar
16. 1 POT OF DWARF DAFFODILS: 1 Cultivar. Pot not to exceed 130mm. Please name cultivar
17. 1 POT SPRING BULBS excluding all forms of narcissi, 1 kind, 1 variety not less than 3 bulbs

18. 1 CONTAINER OF ALPINE OR ROCK GARDEN PLANT/S excluding narcissi. Container not to exceed 228mm
No vases
19. 1 VASE MIXED SPRING FLOWERS (excluding shrubs) 12 stems
20. 1 VASE OF FLOWERING SHRUBS. 3 stems, different kinds 3 stems
21. 1 POT PLANT FLOWERING. Pot not to exceed 228mm
Must have been in the exhibitor's possession for a minimum of 3 months
22. 1 PLANTED CONTAINER with not less than 3 spring flowering varieties.
Any reasonable size. The exhibitor must have prepared the container
23. 1 VASE – Polyanthus 3 stems
24. 1 BOWL – Hellebore heads on water (bowl supplied) minimum 3 heads
25. An exhibit from the vegetable plot

Society Vase sizes – Small for single bloom/stems,
Medium for 3 or more blooms/stems.

NOVICE SECTION

26. 1 POT OF DAFFODILS 'Binkie' 3 bulbs
Pot not to exceed 150mm
27. 1 VASE OF DAFFODILS/NARCISSUS 1 stem
28. 1 VASE OF FLOWERING SHRUBS 3 stems
29. 1 POT PLANT FLOWERING
