

Guidance Notes

1. Each member of the family who wishes to enter must use a separate entry form. Please photocopy if additional forms are required.
2. Completed entry forms, with fees, are to be returned to the Show Secretary (**Charles Mobsby, 17, Padnell Road, Waterloo, PO8 8DZ or email: charles.mobsby@sky.com**) by 6pm on the Thursday prior to the Show. **Exceptionally**, if display space is available, entries will be accepted during staging at twice the entry fee below.
3. Entry Fees:
 Members: 20p/entry
 Non Members: 30p/entry.
4. Date of birth. **Only required for young people** who have entered in any of the classes in Section 12.
5. Column 4. **Only complete this column** to either:
 - **State the space required** for optimum display of your **Handicraft** entry. If to be displayed flat please provide the depth (D) and width (W) of the table space required. If to be supported upright please provide the depth and width of the footprint of the supported item.
 - **Request variety cards** for known cultivars of fruit, vegetable, flower and plant exhibits. If multiple variety cards are required, specify all varieties, with a number in brackets following each variety when more than one card is required - for example 'Corsetto (2)' if 2 cards are required. Additional space for variety card requests is provided in Page 3 – please use an additional sheet if this is insufficient.
6. Column 5.
 If a fruit, vegetable, flower or plant exhibit was grown outside your garden at one of the numbered locations listed on Page 3, enter the number of the location in this column.
