## RULES

1. All entry forms from intending exhibitors must be returned to the Show Secretary, Charles Mobsby, 17 Padnell Avenue, Cowplain PO8 8DZ, before 6pm on the Friday evening prior to the Show.
2. Each exhibitor is limited to only **ONE** exhibit in any one Class. Staging of the exhibits may be carried out from **9am - 11am** on the day of the Show.
3. The decision of the judges, in respect of the relative merits of exhibits, is final and the judges have the right and the power to withhold any prize where the exhibits are considered unworthy.
4. The judging will be in accordance with the Rules and Standards of the Royal Horticultural Society and the National Association of Floral Arrangement Societies.
5. No exhibits are to be removed until after the prize giving at approximately 4pm.
6. Vases will be available at the Show and these are to be emptied by the exhibitor and returned at the end of the Show.

Open 2. Vase of 6 blooms from not less than two Divisions.

23. 1 VASE - Polyanthus 3 stems
24. 1 BOWL - Hellebore heads on water (bowl supplied) minimum 3 heads
25. 1 BOWL - Camelia heads on water (bowl supplied) minimum 3 heads
26. An exhibit from the vegetable plot

Use small Society vases for single blooms/stem Classes,  
and medium vases for multiple bloom/stem Classes.

In Class 14, supporting media such as clay pellets (on sale in store),  
glass marbles/beads or pea shingle may be used instead of pebbles.

Pot not to exceed 150mm
28. 1 VASE OF DAFFODILS/NARCISSI 1 stem

Exhibits may use oasis and may be brought to the Show already arranged.  
They will be judged according to NAFAS Rules.

32. Open: 'Full of the Joys of Spring'. An exhibit.
33. Open: 'Easter Bonnet'. A petite exhibit.  
Depth and width not to exceed 25cm. Height in proportion.

## **FOR YOUR INFORMATION AND GUIDANCE**

### **SYSTEM OF DAFFODIL CLASSIFICATION**

DIVISION 1 - TRUMPETS: the trumpet (corona) is as long or longer than the perianth segments.

DIVISION 2 - LARGE CUP: the cup (corona) is less than the length of the petals (perianth) but more than a  $\frac{1}{3}$ .

DIVISION 3- SMALL CUP: the cup (corona) is less than  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the length of petals (perianth).

DIVISION 4 - DOUBLES: one or more flowers, to the stem, with doubling of the perianth segments or the corona or both.
